

NEBRASKA ASSOCIATION OF FAIR MANAGERS (NAFM)

SHOWCASE RULES:

1. In order to submit an act, each agency or individual act must have been a member in good standing for at least two years.
2. An act may showcase for two consecutive years, and then must lay off one year.
3. Each talent agency or individual act must have a room at the convention hotel
4. Associates that are eligible may submit only one act. A maximum of 12 acts will be selected. **THE FOLLOWING IS NEW FOR 2016**—If more than 12 eligible acts are submitted by the deadline, associates with five or more consecutive years as members will receive preference in showcase selection. Each act will be given a 20 minute time slot.
5. Acts must be submitted by November 10th. A lineup will be mailed/emailed by December 1.
6. Associate in charge of showcase will make the lineup with new or unknown acts going early or late in the lineup. Special needs will be considered with advance notice
7. Showcase hours will be approximately 8:30 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. Friday night and 2:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. Saturday of the annual convention.
8. Introductions will not count as part of the 20 minutes if done by the NAFM MC.
9. The Nebraska Association of Fair Managers will be responsible for selecting the MC's for the showcase
- 10. NO LIVE SHOWCASING WILL BE PERMITTED IN CONVENTION HOTEL ROOMS**
11. The NAFM shall be responsible for providing one or more of the following:
 - A. A room or other suitable facility in which to exhibit the showcase.
 - B. Suitable Stage, Sound Equipment, Power, and Lighting
 - C. Dressing Room(s)
12. Any showcase act or sponsoring agency not adhering to these rules shall be subject to sanctions imposed by the Board of Directors of the NAFM after notice and a hearing.
